QUESTION ONE (20 MARKS)

You have been assigned as a textiles testing specialist at Kenya Bureau of Standards to perform various duties and assignments;

- a) Explain to a colleague three (3) major reasons why you carry out fiber testing. (3 marks)
- b) Identify any three (3) physical features of a fibre that are affected by the amount of moisture they absorb (3 marks)
- c) Elaborate to your boss the difference between primary and secondary characteristics of textile citing any two (2) examples in each case (6 marks)
- As you carry out sampling of fibers before testing, state three (3) main conditions that a good sample must satisfy
 (3 marks)
- e) Explain to your colleague, five requirements for fiber forming polymers (5 marks)

QUESTION TWO (15 MARKS)

You have been provided with different types of textile fibers. Discuss five (5) main methods you would use to identify them

QUESTION THREE (15 MARKS)

With the aid of diagrams, elaborate to your fellow students three (3) methods that are used in measuring tearing strength in fabrics

QUESTION FOUR (15 MARKS)

While measuring fabric thickness, Mr. Ken noticed variation in the results for the same fabric measured twice. Elaborate five (5) factors that might have affected the results.

QUESTION FIVE (15 MARKS)

Explain five (5) primary characteristics of textile fibers.
