CASE STUDY: David Ochieng Maende

David Ochieng Maende, 50, decided to give up his steady paycheck and top management position to try his hand in business. He had worked at Chemelil Sugar Company for 26 years. Maende graduated from University of Nairobi with a Bachelor of Science in Analytical Chemistry. His decision was motivated by the fact that he was increasingly feeling underutilized in terms of the application of the daily routine of one line of chemistry as opposed to the broad chemical base he had acquired in industrial and analytical chemical applications from the university and through experience.
