

Vision

To be the centre of excellence in academic performance and service delivery in technical and business education.

Mission

We are a leading Technical Training Institute providing quality, affordable, sustainable and competitive technical and business education for national development.

History

Machakos Technical Training Institute opened its doors for students way back in January 1957, then called Machakos Technical Rural Training School. It was then taken over by the government and renamed Machakos Technical and Trade School in 1958. It became Machakos Technical Secondary School in 1967.

The Institute was one of the 19 government maintained national technical secondary schools which were upgraded to Post Secondary Technical Training Institutes with the advent of 8-4-4 system of education in 1985. Thus the secondary school curriculum was gradually phased out by 1987 when the last 0-level exams were taken and the institute remained purely a post-school institution.

Status

The institute is managed by a Board of Governors appointed by the Minister for Education, Science and Technology. It also has a Parents Teachers Association (PTA) to assist the B.O.G. especially in matters of development and student discipline.

Currently, the institute has a student enrolment capacity of 1200, with boarding facilities that can accommodate 650 students. This capacity is not fully utilized because most parents still prefer residential training for their children.

The institute has nine academic departments offering 14 diploma and 14 craft certificate training programmes.

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Currently the institute offers 28 different training programmes spread across different levels. The training programmes that have been fully established in last 17 years include:-

- Accounting (KATC, CPA)
- Business Administration (Diploma, Craft)
- Carpentry and Joinery (Craft)
- > Clothing Technology (Diploma, Craft)
- Cooperative Management (Diploma)
- > Electrical Engineering (Diploma, Craft)
- Electronics Engineering (Diploma, Craft)
- Food and Beverage (Diploma, Craft)
- > Human Resource Management (Diploma)
- Information Technology (Diploma)
- Masonry (Craft)
- Mechanical Engineering (Craft)
- Motor Vehicle Engineering (Diploma, Craft)
- Sales and Marketing (Diploma, Craft)
- Secretarial Studies (Diploma, Craft)
- Supplies Management (Diploma, Craft)
- Welding and Fabrication (Craft)

The accounting courses are offered in sections/stages, which last six months each. The diploma programmes last three years whereas the craft training programmes take two years. Students are expected to spend between 5 – 6 months of their total training time on industrial attachment, which is compulsory for students taking craft and diploma programmes. This enables them to gain practical exposure in the world of work as they work alongside other experienced employees in companies, firms or organizations. At Machakos T.T.I. industrial attachment is an important component of the training programme. Hence, it is keenly supervised and rigorously monitored and evaluated.

Besides industrial attachment, all training programmes at Machakos T.T.I are monitored and evaluated constantly in terms of content, structure and duration so as to ensure their relevance to the job market demands. This has led to higher level of performance and work discipline, which enables Machakos T.T.I graduates to gain a competitive edge in the job market.

Students Enrolment

Currently the institute has a student population of 760 students of which 385 are female and 375 are male. Out of this number 140 craft students are out on industrial attachment while 160 are new students who reported this term.

Graduation

The first graduation ceremony was held in the year 2002 after several groups of outgoing students made several requests to the Institute administration to organize some kind of a ceremony to mark the completion of their course. The institute thought that such event could take the form of a graduation ceremony. During the first graduation ceremony 600 graduands participated. It comprised

of graduands from the year 1995 to 2001 who had qualified after taking various exams.

This year the institute is proudly preparing to celebrate its third graduation ceremony after last year's graduation ceremony, which attracted 130 graduands. This year's graduation ceremony will be held on Friday 2nd July 2004 and is expected to attract at least 146 graduands who have fulfilled the KASNEB AND KNEC requirements for the award of various diplomas and certificates.

Future focus

The Institute's management has realized that with the rapid technological advancement and changing business trends, there is need for the institute to undertake internal reforms if it is to remain relevant and competitive. It is with this in mind that a strategic plan for the next five years has been formulated whose official launch will be done in due course.

The plan will build on the achievements of the institute since it was converted into a tertially college. It includes the possibility of upgrading the institute to either a national polytechnic or constituent college or a public university.


