QUESTION ONE (20 MARKS)

- a) Physically handicapped children encounter a number of family problems. Explain five such problems that they are likely to encounter. (10 marks)
- b) Describe the physical and health characteristics of individuals with physically handicapping conditions. (10 marks)
- c) Explain five key members of the multidisciplinary team during the assessment of persons suspected to have PH&OHI clearly outlining the role of each. (10 marks)

QUESTION TWO (20 MARKS)

- a) Examine five intervention programmes for learners/persons with physically handicapping conditions. (10 marks)
- b) Discuss ten key skills that should be incorporated in the preschool curriculum for learners with physical handicaps. (10 marks)

QUESTION THREE (20 MARKS)

- a) Each individual child suspected to have physical handicapping conditions should be assessed and carefully identified by the multidisciplinary team. Discuss eight areas of focus for the team. (16 marks)
- b) Biggs (1982) suggested some critical goals to a successful transition for students with PH&OHI. Explain four of these critical goals. (4 marks)

- a) Discuss five common reactions of non-disabled towards the disabled in the society (10 marks)
- b) Giving relevant examples, explain ten services that persons with physical disability should have access to in order to be fully integrated into the society. (10 marks)
